LPSB Policy: 007

Title: Criminal Intelligence

Approved: May 25, 2000

Procedure: Part 3 Chapter J

Amended: May 21, 2009

1. Policy:

It is the policy of the London Police Services Board with respect to criminal intelligence that:

- a) criminal intelligence will be provided by the London Police Service by utilizing its own members; and
- b) the Chief of Police will:
 - i) establish priorities and procedures for criminal intelligence, including strategic and tactical intelligence;
 - ii) promote the use of criminal intelligence analysis by supervisors to identify areas or issues requiring directed patrol, targeted enforcement, problem-oriented policing initiatives or community-based crime prevention initiatives; and
 - iii) ensure that members who perform the criminal intelligence function have the knowledge, skills and abilities to perform this function and the necessary tools and equipment.
