Title: Court Security

Procedure: Part 9 Chapter C

1. Policy:

It is the policy of the London Police Services Board with respect to court security that the Chief of Police will:

- a) establish a local court security committee, to serve in an advisory capacity to the Chief of Police, comprised of representatives, at minimum, from the police, Crown, judiciary, local bar, victim services/organizations and Court Services - Ministry of the Attorney General;
- b) prepare a court security plan, in consultation with the local court security committee, that adequately addresses local needs and circumstances, and meets the statutory responsibilities set out in section 137 of the *Police Services Act*;
- c) establish procedures on court security that address supervision training; and
- d) ensure that police officers and special constables utilized for court security are supervised and have knowledge, skills and abilities to perform the function.
