LPSB Policy: 022

Title: Stolen or Smuggled Firearms

Procedure: Part 3 Chapter F

Approved: May 25, 2000

1. Policy:

It is the policy of the London Police Services Board with respect to stolen or smuggled firearms that the Chief of Police will develop and maintain procedures:

- a) that require that every firearm that comes into the possession of the LPS will be checked to determine whether the firearm:
 - i) has been reported stolen or lost;
 - ii) is legally registered in Canada; or
 - iii) is smuggled;
- b) on the investigation of stolen or smuggled firearms in accordance with the LPS's criminal investigation procedures; and
- c) that address the sharing of crime analysis, criminal intelligence and other information on stolen or smuggled firearms with relevant law enforcement agencies and as required by section 134(8)4 of the *Police Services Act*.
